

RESOLUTION OF SYMPATHY - ROBERT A. BELMONT (1928-2018)



WHEREAS, this Town Board was deeply saddened to learn of the recent death of Robert A. Belmont; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Belmont faithfully and diligently served this Town and its residents as Supervisor from 1980 to 1986, 1988 to 1994, and as Interim Town Supervisor from March through November 2002; and

WHEREAS, as Town Supervisor, Mr. Belmont played a major role in seeing the following accomplishments realized on his watch: established the refuse transfer station at Town Hall, added a softball field to Sandy Bottom Park, brought cable TV service to Honeoye, adopted the Town Master Plan, successfully resolved a beaver dam controversy that helped to alleviate flooding and drainage issues in the town, and instituted a Town Board liaison system to get council members more involved in government operations; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Belmont was a member of the Ontario County Board of Supervisors, serving on the following Standing Committees: Education, Legislation and Improved Methods, Health Facility, and Personnel; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Belmont served as Chairman of the Personnel Committee, a role in which he was responsible for negotiating labor contracts with Ontario County employees, sheriff's deputies, and the faculty and staff at Finger Lakes Community College; and

WHEREAS, in 1985 and again in 1988, Mr. Belmont was named as Vice-Chairman of the Ontario County Board of Supervisors and he later served as County Budget Officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Town Board, on behalf of its members both past and present, commemorates the life, contributions, and public service of Robert A. Belmont and extends its sincere sympathy to his bereaved family; and further

RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this Board and a copy sent to the Belmont family.
