

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. ____ OF 2018
AMENDING THE ZONING LAW OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND
TO ADOPT REGULATIONS PERMITTING CERTAIN AGRICULTURAL AND
CULINARY TOURISM ACTIVITIES IN THE "A RESIDENTIAL/AGRICULTURAL
DISTRICT"**

WHEREAS, a resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Richmond for a public hearing to be held by said Town Board on October 9, 2018, at 7 p.m. at the Richmond Town Hall, 8690 Main Street, Honeoye, New York, to hear all interested parties on a proposed Local Law entitled, "A Local Law To Amend The Richmond Town Code At Part II "General Legislation," Chapter 200 "Zoning," Article IV "District Regulations," Section 200-7 "Definitions" To Add Definitions Of Terms Relating To Agricultural Tourism And To Amend Section 200-12 "A Residential/Agricultural District," Sub-Section D "Special Use Permits" To Add §200-12(D)(9) And §200-12(D)(10) Permitting Certain Agricultural And Culinary Tourism Activities In The "A Residential/Agricultural District" After A Special Use Permit Is Granted"; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the official newspaper of the Town of Richmond, on September 27, 2018 and all other notices required by law to be given were properly served, posted or given; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on October 9, 2018, at 7 p.m. at the Richmond Town Hall, 8690 Main Street, Honeoye, New York, and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to part 617 of the implementing regulations pertaining to Article 8 (State Environmental Quality Review Act) of the Environmental Conservation Law it has been determined by the Town Board that adoption of said Local Law would not have a significant effect upon the environment and could be processed by other applicable governmental agencies without further regard to SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Richmond, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Town of Richmond to adopt said Local Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Richmond hereby adopts said Local Law No. ____ of 2018, entitled, "A Local Law To Amend The Richmond Town Code At Part II "General Legislation," Chapter 200 "Zoning," Article IV "District Regulations," Section 200-7 "Definitions" To Add Definitions Of Terms Relating To Agricultural Tourism And To Amend Section 200-12 "A Residential/Agricultural District," Sub-Section D "Special Use Permits" To Add §200-12(D)(9) And §200-12(D)(10) Permitting Certain Agricultural And Culinary Tourism Activities In The "A Residential/Agricultural District" After A Special Use Permit Is Granted", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and she hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and in the Local Law Book of the Town of Richmond, to give due

notice of the adoption of said local law to the Secretary of State of New York, to publish an abstract of this local law in the Town's official newspaper and to post a copy of this local law on the Town of Richmond sign board.
