

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SCHEDULING OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE ZONING LAW OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND TO CREATE A NEW PARKS AND OPEN SPACE ZONING DISTRICT AND TO ADD REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO SUCH NEW ZONING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Richmond, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interests of the Town to schedule a public hearing to solicit public comment upon a proposed Local Law to Amend the Zoning Law of the Town of Richmond to Create a New Parks and Open Space Zoning District and to Add Regulations Pertaining to Such New Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Richmond has reviewed the draft of the aforementioned proposed Local Law attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and deems it in the best interests of the Town of Richmond to proceed in accordance with the Code of the Town of Richmond and the Laws of the State of New York in adopting said Local Law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby is, directed to schedule a public hearing to be held on _____, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. at the Richmond Town Hall, 8690 Main Street, Honeoye, New York; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk, be and hereby is, authorized to forward to the official newspapers of the Town a Notice of Public Hearing in the form substantially the same as that attached hereto as Exhibit "2"; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby is, directed to post a copy of the proposed Local Law on the Town of Richmond sign board and take any and all other necessary actions to properly bring the aforementioned Local Law before the Town Board of the Town of Richmond for its consideration; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to provide all other notices as required by law for the adoption of this local law.
